**SMARTEST**

Troodon - largest brain to body size

**OLDEST**

Eoraptor - about 230 million years ago

**SCARIEST**

Tyrannosaurus rex

**BIGGEST EGG**

Segnosaurus - 48 cms

**LONGEST NECK**

Mamenchisaurus - 11 metres or about the length of a bus

**BIGGEST HEAD**

Torosaurus - over 2 metres

**LARGEST CARNIVORE**

Spinosaurus - 17 metres (yes it was bigger than T-rex -13 metres)

**SMALLEST**

Micropachycephalosaur - 50 cms

**LONGEST NAME**

Micropachycephalosaur

**HEAVIEST**

Argentinosaurus - 90 tonnes (same as 18 big elephants)

**LONGEST**

Seismosaurus - 39 metres nearly four buses!

**FASTEST**

Gallimimus - 60 kph

Megalosaurus - 1824

**WIDEST**

Ankylosaurus - 5 metres

**TALLEST**

Ultrasaurus - 21 metres as high as a six-storey building
